Dear Patient

In a little while, you will be undergoing a surgical intervention in our hospital. Your attending doctor has already explained to you the procedures of this surgery. All necessary documents relating to anaesthesia as well as the personal questionnaire form, which you should complete and return to us, are attached to this letter.

We are anxious to make your stay with us as enjoyable as possible and to personally accompany you in an adequate professional manner. In return, we also depend upon your help.

During your stay, following is at your disposal:

- Parking spaces in and around our building
- Lounge/waiting room/lockers
- Rest room and showers
- Beverages/snacks after the procedure
- Various literature / music
- Free Wi-Fi-internet access
- EC / Postcard / credit card terminal

Procedure from A to Z

Prior to the intervention

Your surgeon has informed you about our operation appointment. **We shall inform you in due time about the exact entry time.**

Make sure that you will have read and understood the attached anaesthesia information. It is **important that these are carefully adhered to.**

As per the information about anaesthesia, be especially attentive and follow strictly **the fasting guidelines before** the intervention.

We kindly request that you send us back the completed patient questionnaire by mail/fax/e-mail no later than 5 days prior to the intervention appointment.

If only **local anaesthesia** with or without attendance (stand-by) is planned, you may bring us back the completed questionnaire **on the day of the surgery.**

Please remember to **sign the consent form** on the patient information sheet and **take it with you on the surgery day.**

After your arrival at Euro-Polyclinic, please, contact our reception desk in the foyer.

During your stay with us

After your registration at the front desk, you will be asked to have a seat in the waiting area until you will be welcomed by the responsible nurse who will accompany you to your personal preparation area, where you may get changed and will be prepared for the intervention. The responsible anesthesiologist will review what will be happening next and will answer any questions you may have. In order to assure your safety at all times, you will constantly be monitored by our experienced and highly qualified personnel, throughout the surgery as well as afterwards in the recovery room.

After the surgery

After the intervention you will be cared for in the recovery room. A short recovery period will follow and after this, you may leave the Euro-Polyclinic again, **accompanied** by somebody. Please, pay attention to the fact that after the intervention **you will legally be considered unfit to binding agreements and to traffic in public** and you are **not allowed to spend the first night unaccompanied**.

Furthermore, we will be giving you some documentation concerning the postoperative conduct, the necessary pain therapy and possibly some medication.

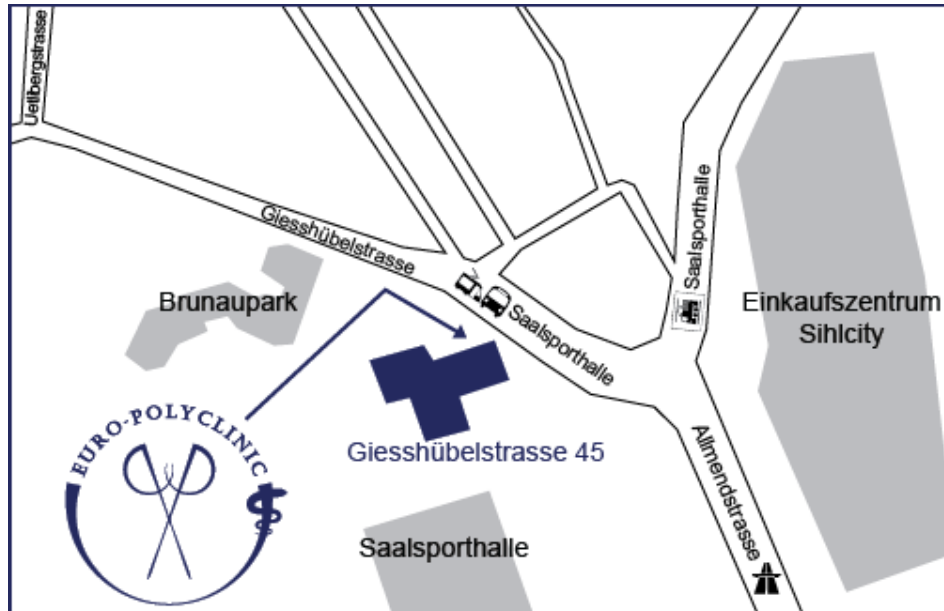

Area map and how to find us



No matter how, a convenient and uncomplicated arrival and departure is guaranteed.

By car

Direct highway connection Zürich-Brunau, direction Chur. From Zug, Aargau, Lucerne and Bern, the Euro-Polyclinic can be reached quickly via the A3 Uetliberg tunnel (Zurich's west bypass = *Zürcher Westumfahrung*). GPS: Giesshübelstrasse 45, CH-8045 Zürich.

Our clinic owns sufficient parking places. However, should all the parking places unexpectedly be occupied, more public parking places are available in adjacent proximity in the Brunaupark and the Sihlcity multi-storey car parks (both with parking fees).

After a surgery, you will not be fit to drive or otherwise move about in traffic on your own. So therefore, please, make sure to be picked up by somebody.

By public transport

The Euro-Polyclinic can also be easily and quickly reached by public transport: both by train and by various tramway and bus lines. From Zurich main train station the S4 takes just 7 minutes.

- Tramways No. 5, 13 and 17, station Saalsporthalle
- Bus No. 89, station Saalsporthalle
- Sihltalbahn / Sihltal train S4, station Saalsporthalle / Sihlcity
- Express bus (Schnellbus) 444 and 445, station Saalsporthalle / Sihlcity
- Postbus lines 200 and 210, station Saalsporthalle / Sihlcity
